Course Details

Gavar State University conducts General English classes at the first, second and fourth levels. At the successful completion of the first level the participant 1. Will have a good command in using basic grammar and language functions. 2. Will have an ability to communicate accurately and appropriately about their life, work and interests in simple everyday situations. At the successful completion of the second level the participant 1. Will acquire relevant vocabulary. 2. Will build communicative competence in listening, speaking, reading and writing. 3. Will have a more balanced development of listening and speaking skills to ensure effective communication At the successful completion of the fourth level the participant 1. Will expand communicative competence in listening, speaking, reading and writing. 2. Will use complex grammatical structures and vocabulary relevant to a variety of social and workplace. 3. Will increase fluency and accuracy to improve communication in different social and workplace situations. 4. Will use grammatical structures and relevant vocabulary under the guidance of communicative approach.

Entry requirements

In case of applying for a higher level than level 1, participants need to pass a placement test to be selected for their preferred level.

Career prospects

Thanks to the course, the student becomes competitive in the labour market and develops foreign language skills, gets an opportunity of using foreign language sources and staying in touch with native speakers, becomes more required in the labour market, acquires increased options for employability.



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
