### Course Overview

At the beginning of the course learners acquire theoretical knowledge, and a list of documents is offered the study of which enhances necessary knowledge about human rights. In the middle of the course moots are conducted based on knowledge acquired. Then, the learners work with stakeholders, brush up their practical knowledge, make up legal documents, prepare lawsuits, and work with court documents. During the practical part of the course, the learners pay a visit to law-enforcement agencies, take part in hearings, volunteer with the Public Defender and in the Ombudsman Institutions. In the last stage of the course learners' knowledge is assessed.

### Course Details

At the successful completion of the course the participant 1. Will have an understanding of the concept of human natural rights, basic principles of person's legal status, internal and international-legal aspects of citizenship and dual citizenship. 2. Will have a command of domestic protection of human rights. 3. Will gain comprehensive knowledge to promote some activities as a staff member of a Human Rights defender. 4. Will gain relevant knowledge to be employed by comprehensive international and regional organizations on protecting human rights. 5. Will gain knowledge about filing and submitting a claim in the European Court of Human Rights.

### Entry requirements

- **All students of Law Faculty are eligible to participate in the course**
- **Course participants are selected based upon the interview results**
