Course Overview

A "ToT of Adult Learning Methods" curriculum for Adult Learning and Education can be used worldwide, across all borders. The curriculum offers sufficient scope for variability, allowing for different needs to be met in individual cases. It is structured in a competency-oriented manner. The existing diversity of cultures and customs as well as the social, political and economic framework conditions are recognised in the concept of the Curriculum "ToT of Adult Learning" and are appropriately taken into account. Lesson phases could prepare the self-learning phases and support the professional application of what has been learned through targeted work and reflection assignments. In this way, theory and practice could be optimally linked together.

Adults should feel at ease in the classrooms and have enough space for working in small groups and for exercises. In terms of didactic aids, the teachers should have appropriate media and technical tools at their disposal, without this being bindingly specified.
